Dr. Ruben Juarez is the HMSA Distinguished Endowed Professor at the University of Hawaii Economic Research Organization and the Department of Economics at the University of Hawaii. He also serves as the CEO of Hawaii Integrated Analytics, co-director and co-founder of the Maui Wildfire Exposure Study, and the Pacific Alliance Against COVID-19.

<u>Academic Contributions:</u> Dr. Juarez is an economist known for integrating microeconomics, behavioral economics, and network economics with public health initiatives. Since earning his Ph.D. in Economics from Rice University in 2008, he has published extensively in journals such as the Journal of Economic Theory, Games and Economic Behavior, and the American Journal of Public Health.

<u>Community Engagement and Leadership:</u> Dr. Juarez is dedicated to enhancing community health, particularly for underserved populations. He co-founded and co-directs the Maui Wildfire Exposure Study, which addresses the health impacts of the 2023 Maui wildfires. He also cofounded the Pacific Alliance Against COVID-19, improving health outcomes and vaccination rates for Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander communities. Additionally, he co-leads the Hawaii Social Epigenomics of Early Diabetes Cohort to prevent diabetes in young adults and co-directs the UHERO Statewide Rapid Survey, studying social determinants of health across Hawaii. Among more than a dozen other community-based projects.
